<b>Description:</b> Cyberspace 300 is a Professional Continuing Education (PCE) course presented at the TS/SCI level for the deliberate development of cyberspace professionals in the second half of their careers. Students' career experience, training, and education are leveraged to develop a strategic focus for the integration and application of cyberspace capabilities in Joint Military Operations. (This is not a beginner/introductory class.)								
<b>Eligibility Criteria for Cyberspace Professionals:</b>								
<b>Officer:</b> Level 2 Cyberspace Professional, TAFCSO of 12-15 years; minimum 72 months cyber experience								
<b>Enlisted:</b> Level 2 Cyberspace Professional; SMSgt/SMSgt selects regardless of year group; MSgt with a TAFMSO of 14-18 years; minimum 72 months cyber experience								
<b>Civilian:</b> GS-13 and 14 in cyberspace ops or acquisition positions; minimum 72 months cyber experience								
<b>Selection (Active Duty AF):</b>								
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• SCPMO establishes student quotas for classes and generates the list of eligible candidates and sends a course announcement to appropriate organizations</li> <li>• Organizations deconflict their eligible candidates against class dates and return their list (prioritized order of candidates with preferred class dates) to the SCPMO</li> <li>• SCPMO populates classes with an initial load and posts rosters to the SCPMO website</li> <li>• AF CyTCoE sends a course notification (Welcome Packet) to students approximately 60 days prior to class start</li> <li>• Individual requests to change or cancel class dates must have wing commander (or equivalent) authorization</li> </ul>								
<b>Selection (Reserves and Guard):</b>
